Night Watchers - My picture book of touch

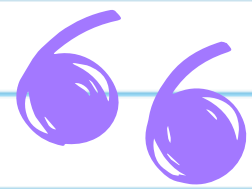
Night watchers are totem animals.

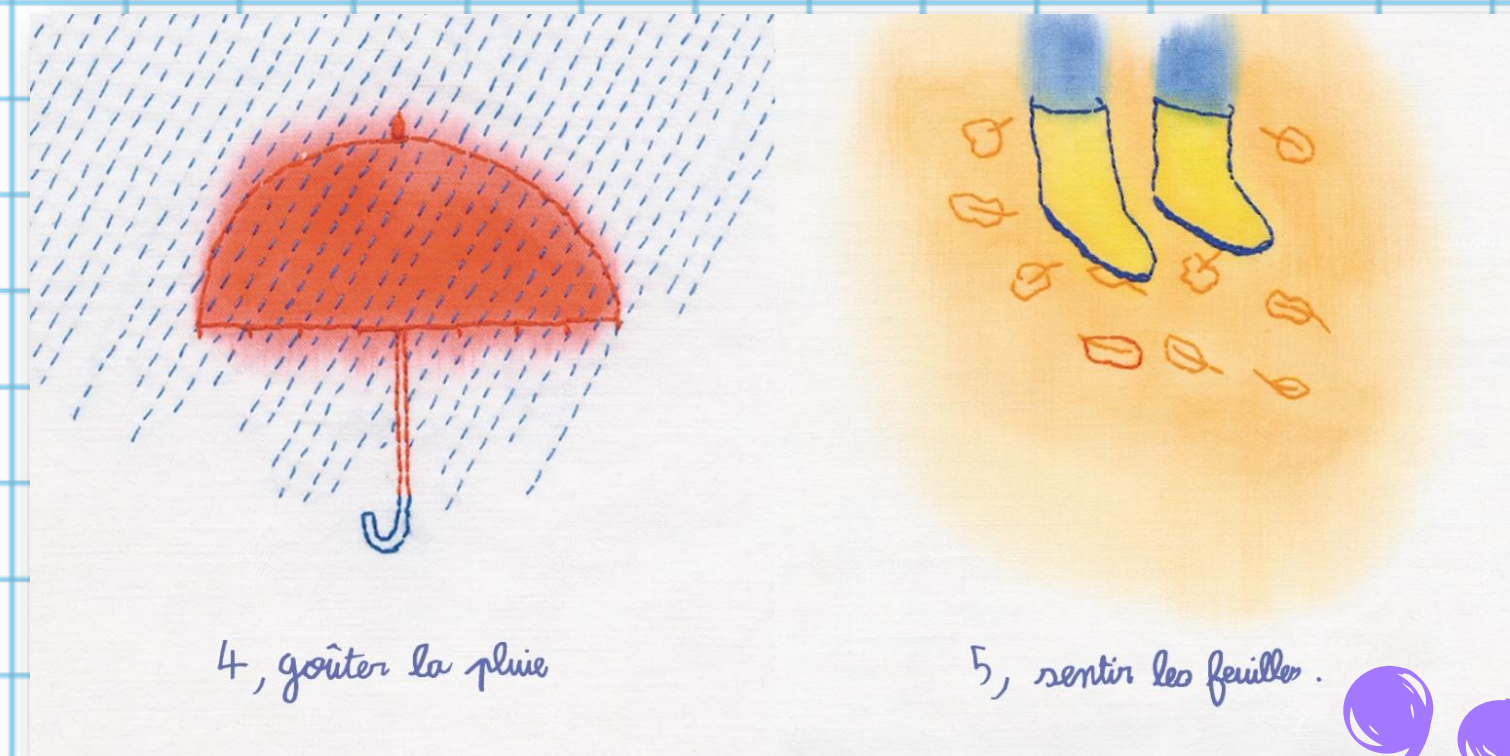
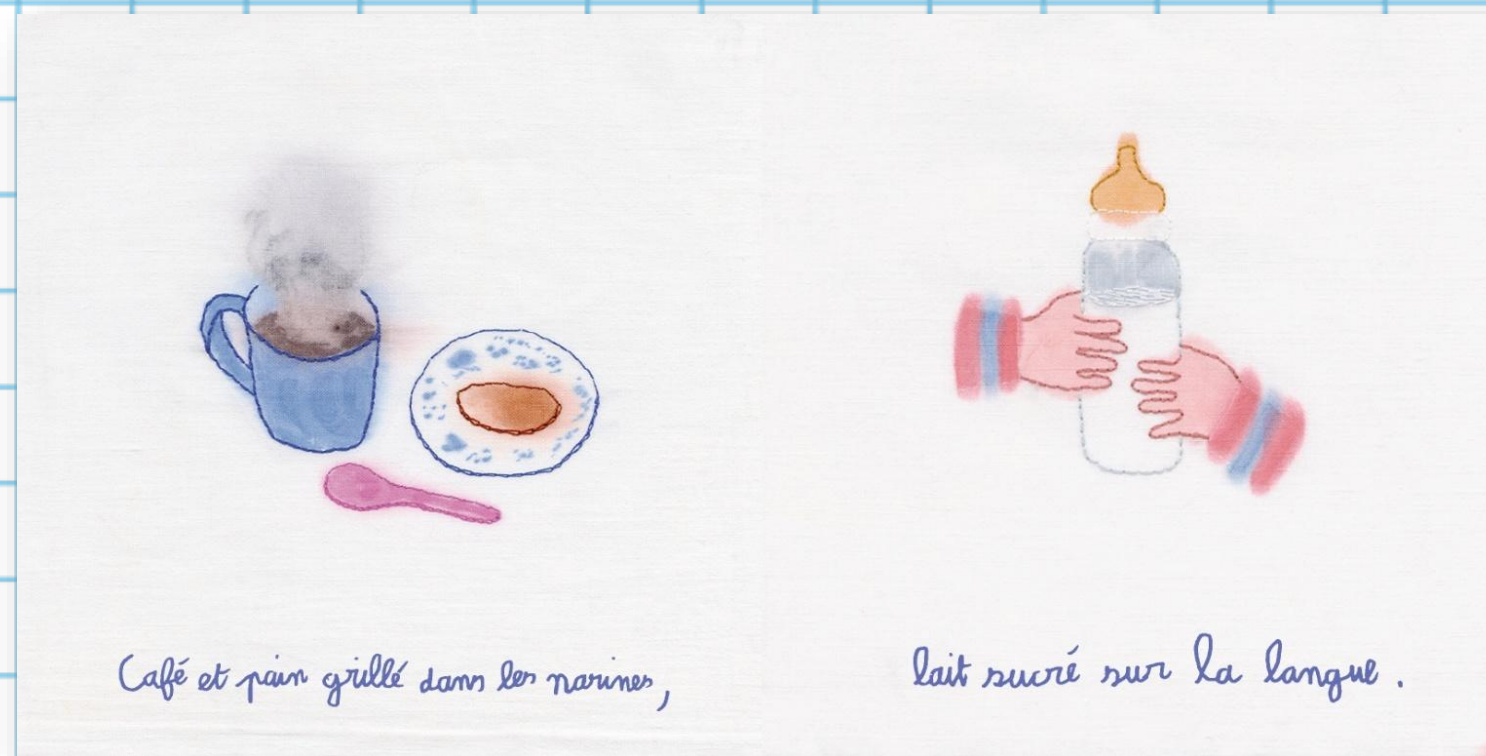

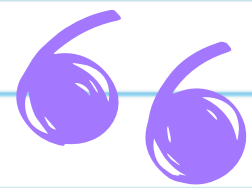
Autumn Refrain - My picture book of the 5 senses

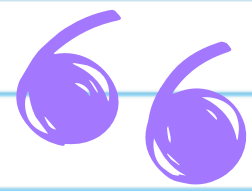
Snow - My picture book of sight

Caroline Bizien takes us on a wonderful olfactory journey along the coastline to discover the flora and fauna of this beloved seaside.

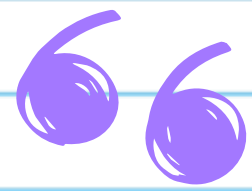

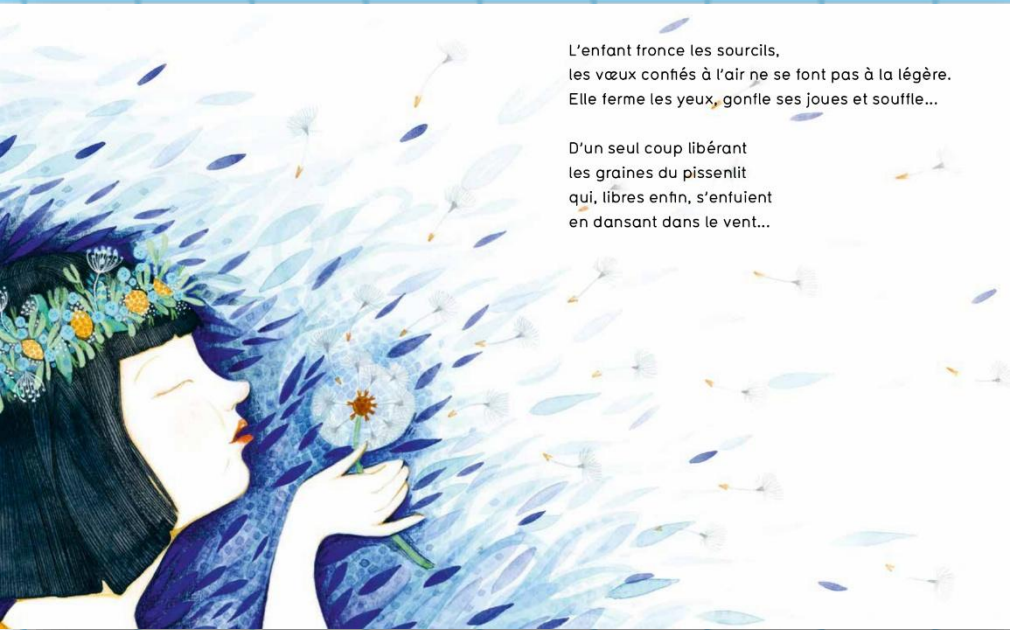
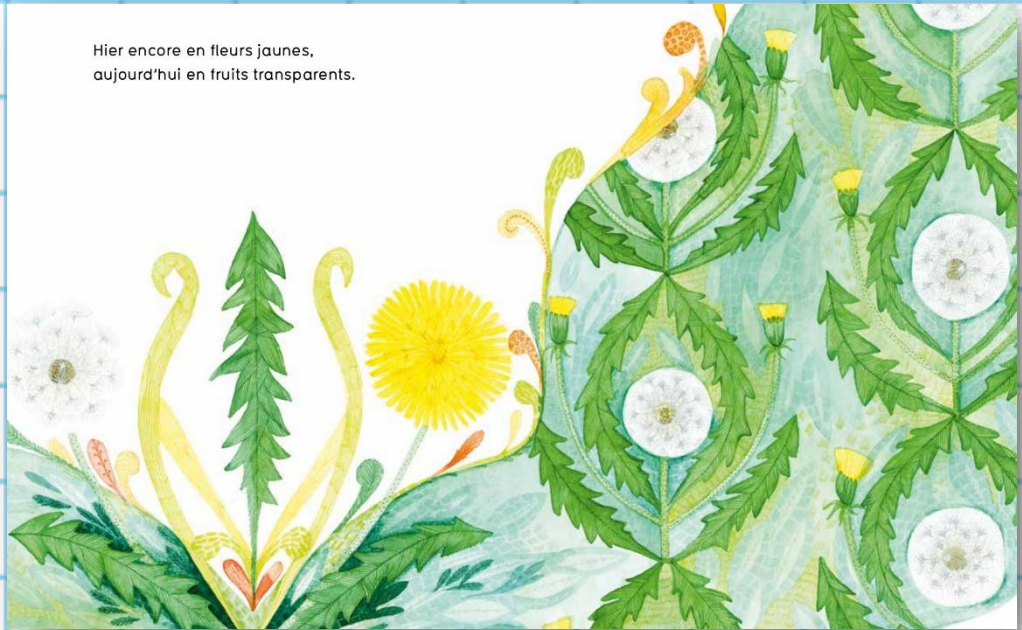
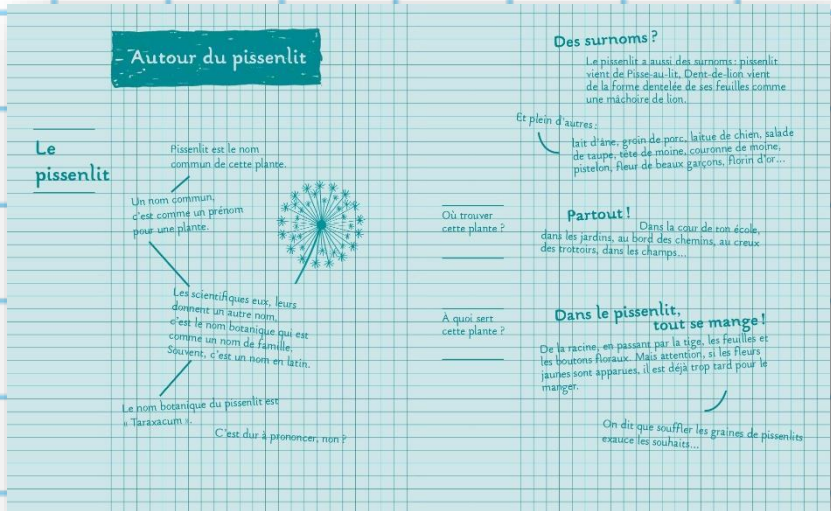


LE GENIE PISSENLIT The Lucky Dandelion

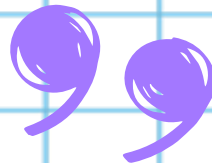
What if every dandelion were a genie, waiting for a child to make a wish?

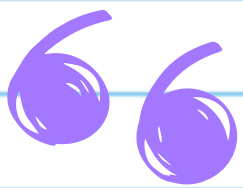
Alone in his field, the dandelion is bored. But does he know he's a genie?

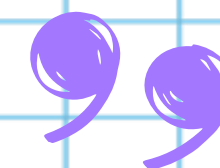
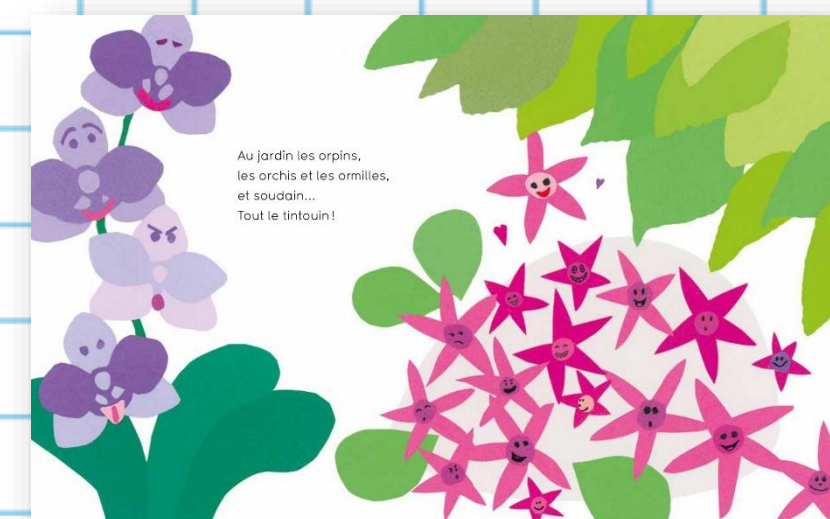
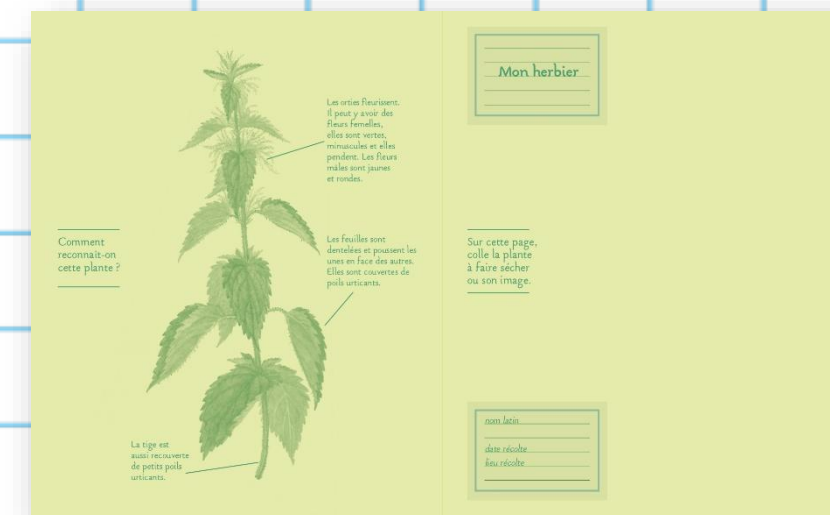


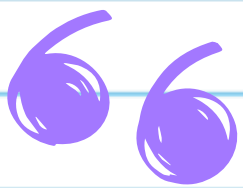
L'ORTIE QUI PIQUE The Stinging Nettle

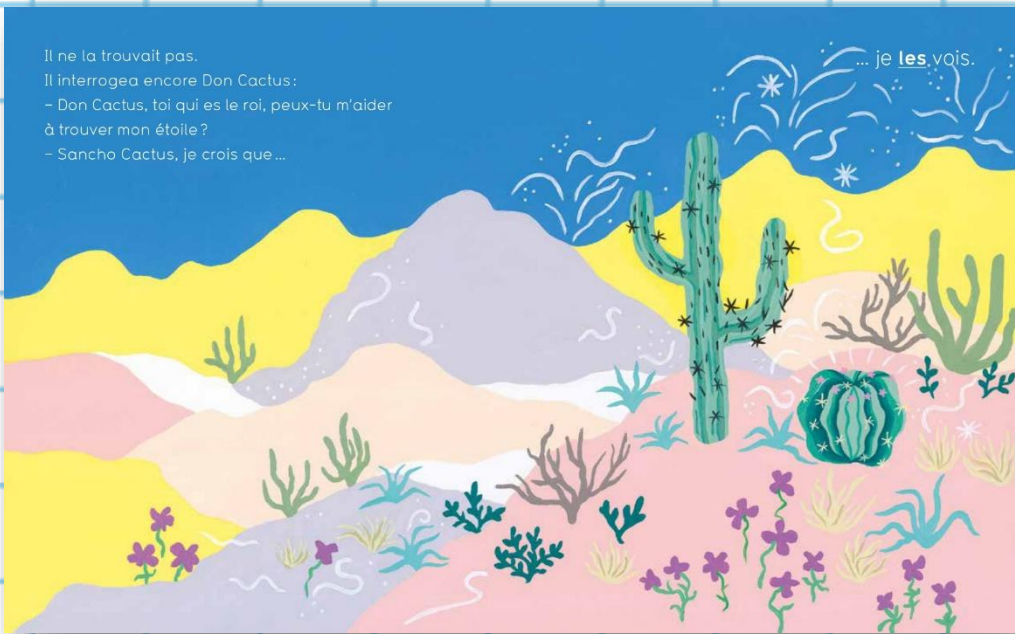
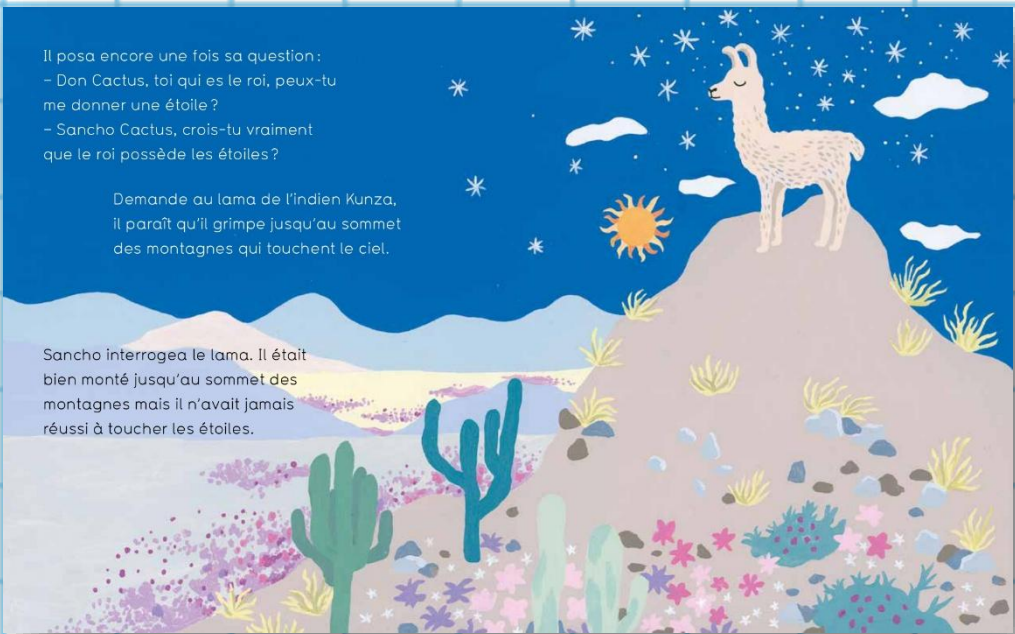
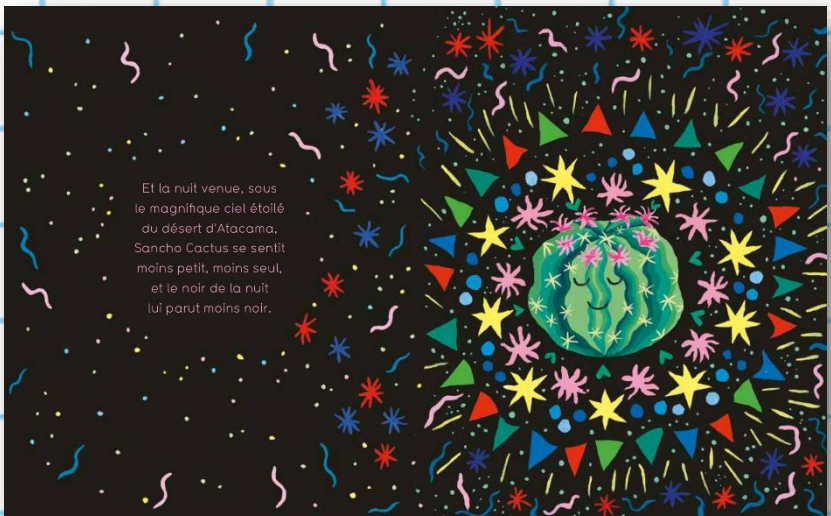
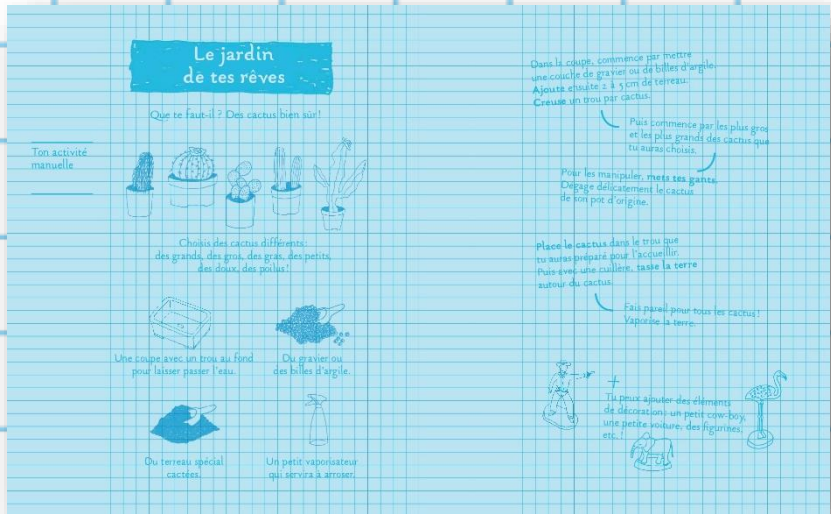


LE RÊVE DE SANCHO CACTUS Sancho Cactus's Dream

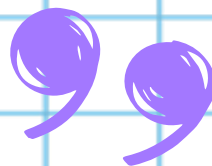
A heartwarming picture book about self-confidence and discovering your inner light.

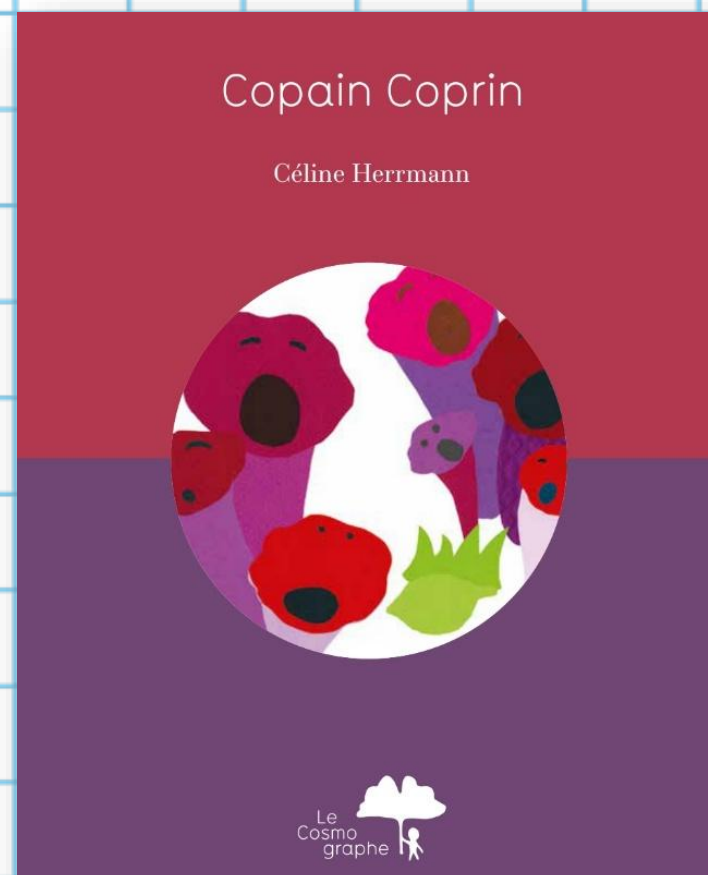

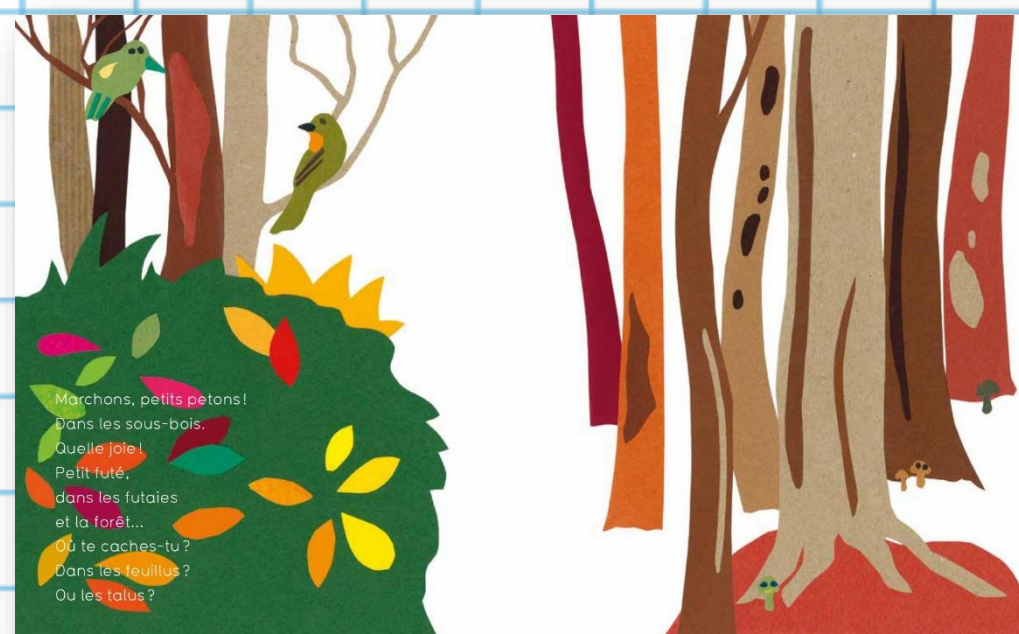
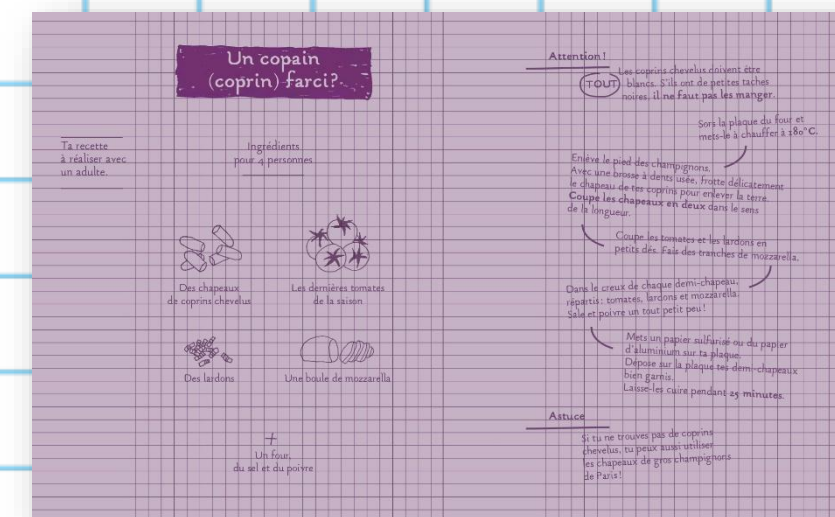


COPAIN COPRIN Mushroom Buddy

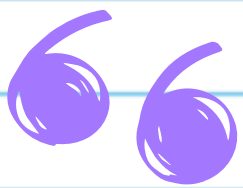
A joyful and richly illustrated picture book that takes young readers on an autumn adventure to discover the fascinating world of wild mushrooms.

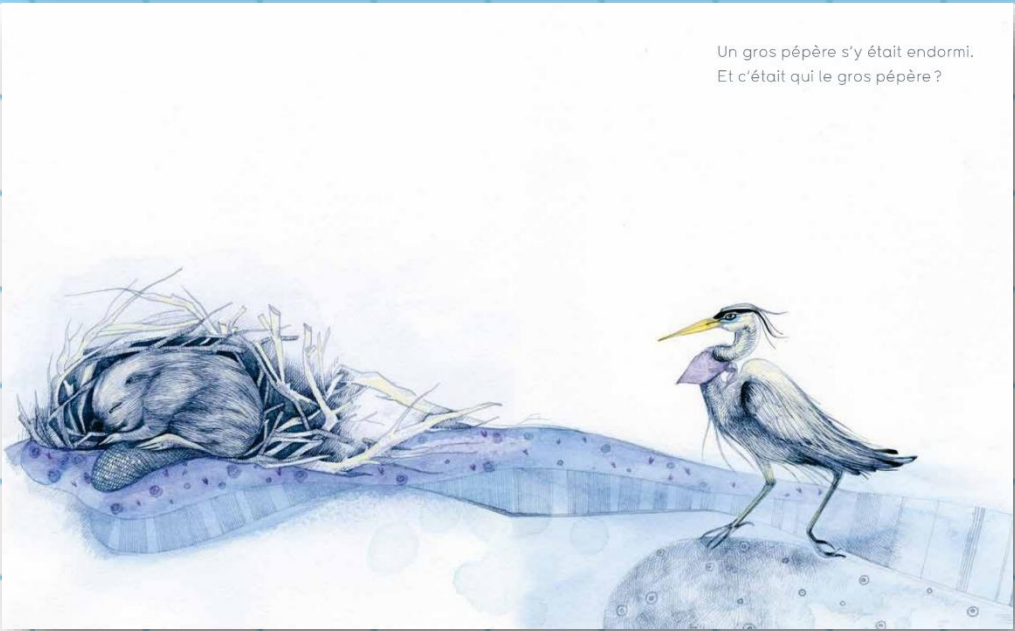
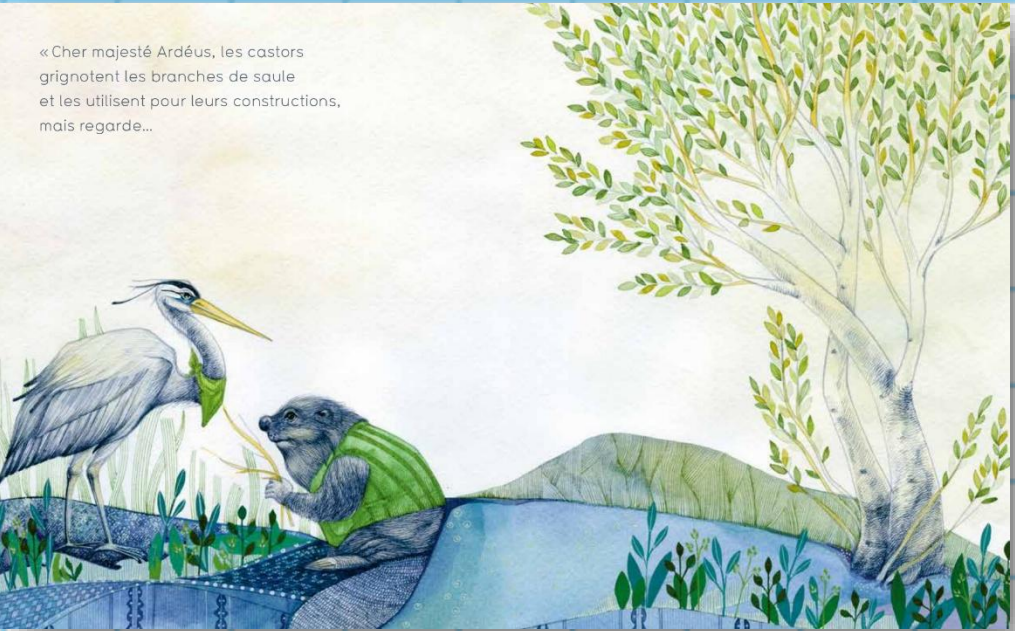
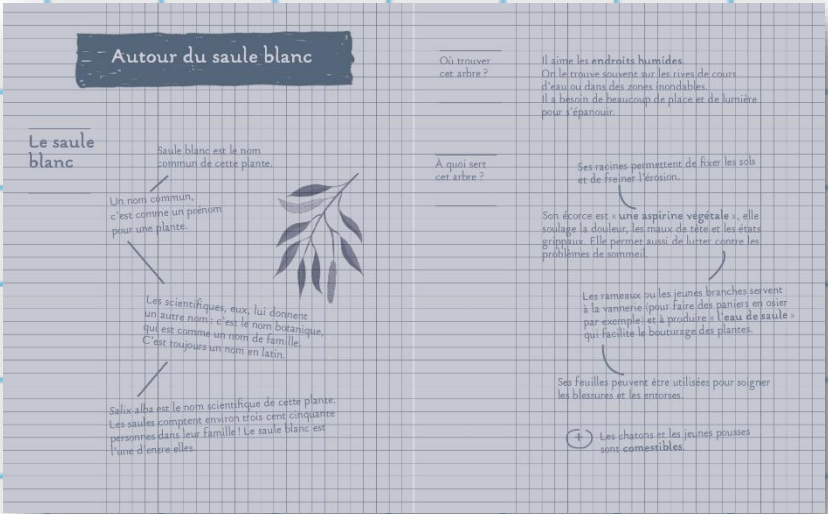


SALIX AU BORD DE L'EAU Salix by the Water

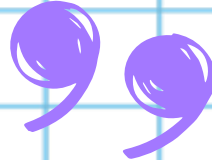
Salix au Bord de l'Eau offers a gentle and optimistic story showing that cooperation is at the heart of the natural world.

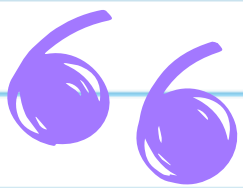
On the banks of a peaceful pond grows Salix, a graceful young willow admired by Ardeus the heron. When Pollux the beaver begins chewing its branches, the heron fears disaster. But as the story unfolds, children discover that the willow, the beaver and the heron are not enemies—they are all part of the same living ecosystem, where each species plays an essential role.

- This picture book introduces young readers to the **ecology of wetlands**, the remarkable **regenerative powers of the willow** and the **importance of biodiversity**.
- Educational pages are complemented by **hands-on activities**, including willow propagation, a simple braiding project inspired by traditional basket weaving, and an herbarium page.

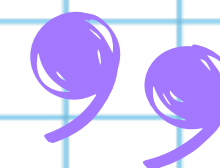
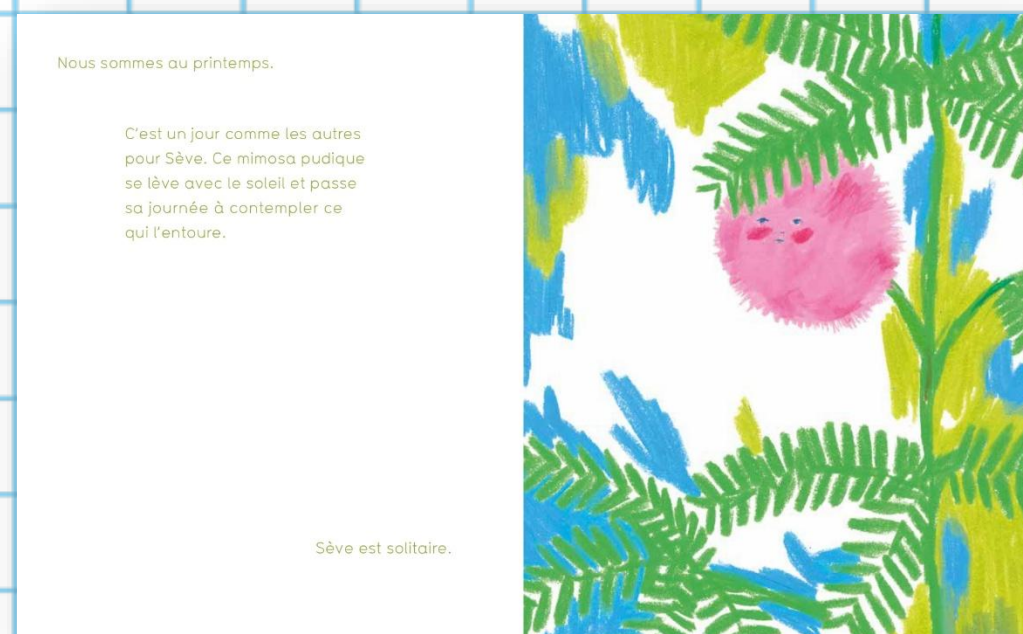
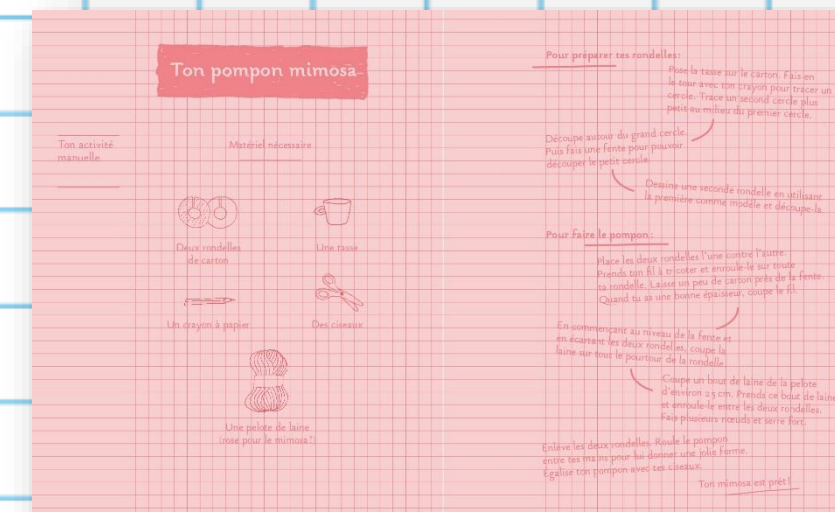
SEVE, LE MIMOSA PUDIQUE Sap, The Blushing Mimosa

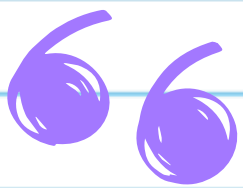
Sometimes all it takes is one encounter for a shy little flower to finally open up!

Sève is a mimosa pudica, the plant that shies away at the slightest touch. She spends her days alone, quietly watching the world, until a curious little white animal named Lotte stumbles upon her hiding place.

What begins as a startled "I'm sorry, did I scare you?" turns into a conversation that lasts an entire day. And by nightfall, two solitary creatures have become friends.

- A tender, quietly funny story about **shyness**, **curiosity**, and the **courage** it takes to let someone stay.
- Engaging **educational pages** with a step-by-step gardening activity spread, a craft activity teaching kids to make a yarn pompom and an herbarium.

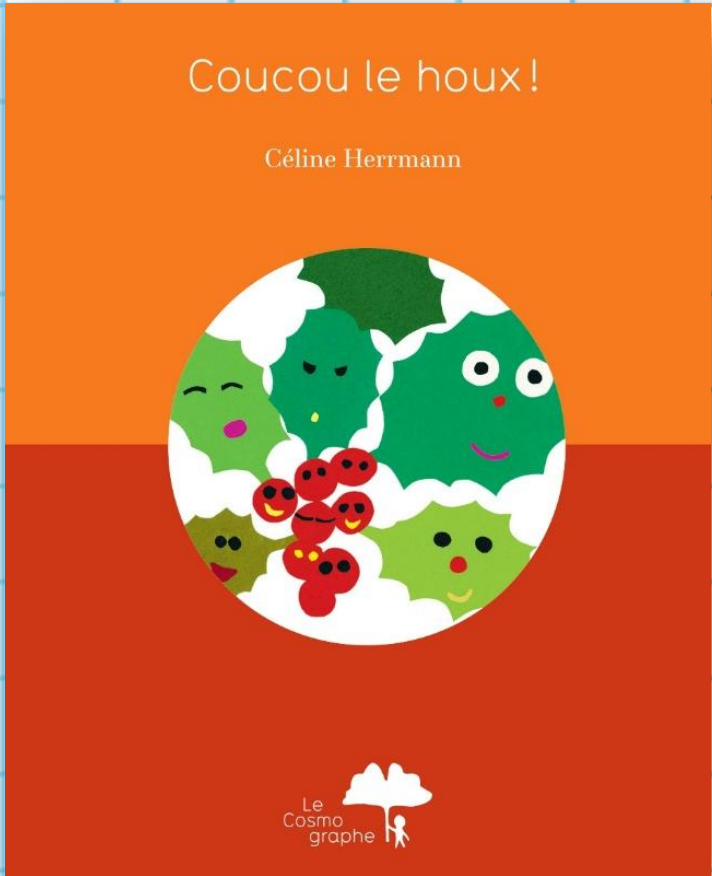

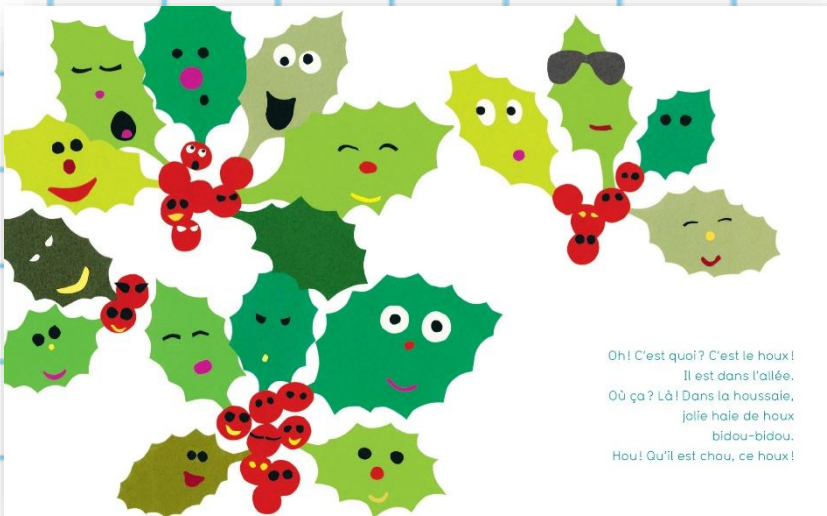
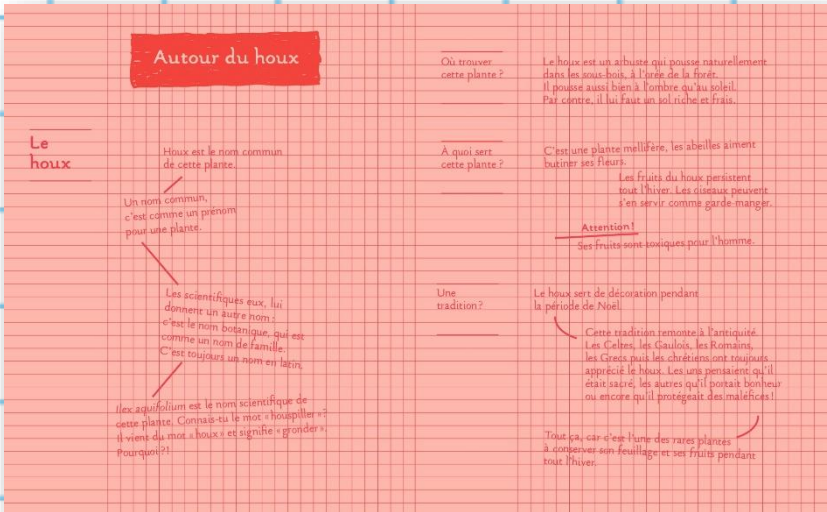


COUCOU, LE HOUX ! Hello Holly!

A joyful intergenerational adventure that turns a winter nature walk into a playground.

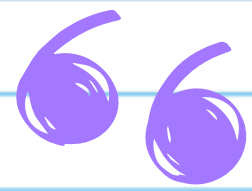
On a hushed, snow-muffled morning, little Titi and his grandfather set off on a walk through the winter forest – and everything they meet gets a burst of playful description: snowflakes, a grumbling marmot in her puffy coat, sleepy snowdrops, a curious squirrel, a grumpy owl, a soft white ermine... until, at last, they stumble on the holly bush itself, prickly and proud in his hedge. Titi crowns himself king with a holly wreath, and grandfather reminds him: this plant is for looking at, not for eating!

- Snowflakes, marmots, and one very prickly plant: a winter walk like no other!
- Engaging **educational pages** with explanations, two hands-on activities (building a winter bird feeder from an orange and seeds, and making a holly Christmas wreath) and an herbarium.

LES CORPS-PAYSAGES The Land In Me

Did you know that bodies can blend into landscapes?
That a knee can suddenly transform into a hill?

Tom has petal-eyes. Bachir has feather-fingers. Naïma has an oasis of hair.

One by one, eight children are revealed through a single striking image of a body part, followed by a full-bleed landscape it becomes: Hammer-feet that invite us to drum the ground to make the earth tremble; hair like an oasis that transforms into a palm tree; feather-fingers that take flight like storks.

In this picture book made of analogies, each part of the body becomes a landscape, like an invitation to movement or contemplation.

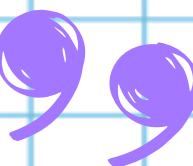
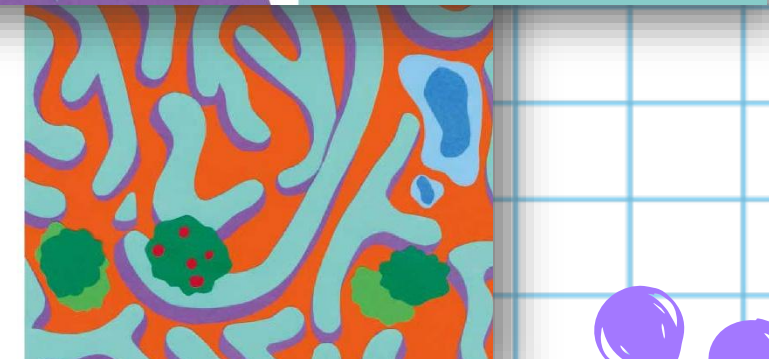
- *Les Corps-paysages* is an image-driven picture book that turns the child's body into a world worth wandering: **playful, visually bold, and quietly poetic.**
