A handyman rabbit has always dreamed of building his own house. One fine morning, he discovers a peaceful meadow. It's the ideal place!

He decides to get to work right away...The reader participates in the construction by choosing between a brick or wooden house, then between a tiled or straw roof...

To progress in the story, two solutions are proposed. With each page turned, a new possibility opens up. Then, from choice to choice, the deceptive simplicity of the beginning of the story quickly gives way to an adventure punctuated by strange encounters that lead the rabbit into a labyrinth where creation, imagination, time travel, dreams and legends are intertwined!

The labyrinth is strewn with pitfalls and traps that lead the reader to return to square one or to find the same sequence several times.

But there is of course an end to the story (the exit from the labyrinth), more or less easy to find!




